## NEIGHBORHOOD DISTRICTS

Neighborhood zoning districts are **primarily residential**, but may include other uses that serve people living in that area, including **community gardens, schools, and religious institutions**, as well as **local shops or businesses**, among other things. Neighborhoods make up the largest part of the city by land area.

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## COMMERCIAL DISTRICTS

Commercial zoning districts may include **any combination of retail, office and residential uses** (except for C, which would not allow residential). They can also include **civic uses such as public buildings and religious institutions**. Commercial zoning districts correlate to the Corridors, Nodes and Central Areas in the SLUP.
